A message from our Governors...

"In July 2017, £1.3bn of government funding was announced to help schools transition to the new national funding formula (NFF) in 2019/20. The new NFF takes into account consistency in distribution of school funding nationally.

Careful financial planning resulted in carry forward budget amounts at the end of April 2017 Financial Year at both Fairlawn and Haseltine. It is to be acknowledged, however, that both schools must continue to reduce expenditure, as cost pressures are expected to increase in real terms over the next 3 years, driving down this outturn.

As we formalise our 2018/19 budget and reforecast our financial position, we wanted to take this brief opportunity to confirm our commitment to managing prudent financial statements in partnership with pupils, parents, staff and governors who we recognise and thank for continuing to drive our schools vision and values under these challenging circumstances."




